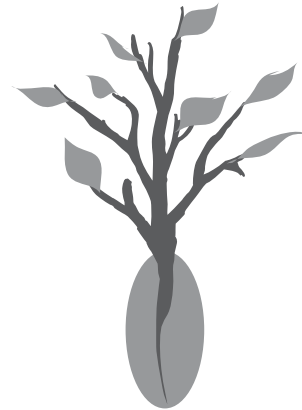

RULES FOR APPLICATION AND SELECTION OF AWARD WINNERS

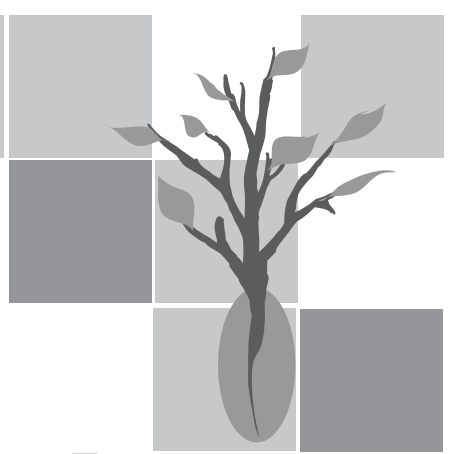
1. Students must apply for the STAY in School Awards.
2. Students applying for these awards must be Six Nations band members.
3. All students applying for these awards must have been in full-time attendance during the 2008-2009 school year.
4. Students must submit a photocopy of their June 2009 report card.
5. All marks given in all math strands and science for reports 1, 2 and 3 must be averaged.
6. Average marks must be verified by the principal of the school in which the student attended for the 2008-2009 school year.
7. Applications are to be mailed directly to the address on the application form and will be accepted if postmarked by October 9, 2009. Fax copies will only be accepted if the original documents are also mailed directly to the address on the application form and are postmarked by October 9, 2009. Fax copies can be sent to fax number 519-339-4491, Attn: Julie Ferguson. Original document information will be used to determine eligibility for award should any discrepancy exist in faxed transcripts.
8. The SEED steering committee, made up of representatives from Imperial Oil and Six Nations, will determine the winners based on the criteria.
9. Winners will be notified as soon as possible and will be asked to attend an awards recognition in November 2009.
10. Average must be higher than 70 per cent.

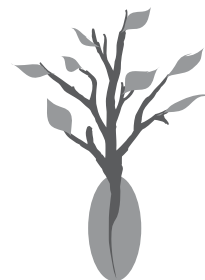
